Ignition duties are handled via a dual-point setup, while custom-fabricated stainless headers flow into side pipes for an unmistakable tone. Backing the blown small-

block is a period-correct Borg-Warner T-10 4-speed transmission with a Hurst "Competition Plus" shifter, connected through a Zoom clutch and lightweight aluminum flywheel. The drivetrain is built to handle the added horsepower, with a reinforced chassis, upgraded suspension components, ladder bars, and a rear end geared at 4.11 for aggressive acceleration. The exterior is finished in a deep candy brick red layered over a silver base, with subtle pearl accents enhancing the classic Corvette lines. The paintwork is show-quality, highlighting the car's iconic curves while maintaining a tasteful custom aesthetic. The interior, trimmed in gray velour with coordinated carpeting, remains largely stock in layout, with discreet additions including auxiliary gauges for performance monitoring. Rolling on Center Line wheels wrapped in BFGoodrich radial T/As, this Corvette sits with the perfect stance. Ready for both show judging and boulevard cruising. Built with an eye for detail and a passion for performance, "Cracklin' Rose" represents a bygone era of hot rod ingenuity.
